- Be open and respectful towards Indigenous Culture with a willingness to listen, learn and deliver outcomes that maintain and promote Aboriginal Cultural Heritage;
- Respect Indigenous traditions and protect cultural heritage sites;
- Identify and promote opportunities for Indigenous people for maintenance of their culture and traditions and economic independence by providing training, employment and investment opportunities where opportunities arise;
- Conduct activities and operations in accordance with relevant Native Title and Cultural Heritage Acts and Regulations by giving due consideration to the relevant cultural heritage requirements;
- Ensure that all employees, contractors and management are aware of their obligations regarding the protection of cultural heritage;
- Ensure the policy remains fit-for-purpose, encourages best practice and drives our cultural heritage planning and continuous improvement processes in cultural heritage management in consultation with traditional owners.
